Dr. Vines is a nursing adjunct professor for Oregon Health & Science University and the University of Portland, and a community health adjunct professor for Portland State University. She is in the American Leadership Forum of Oregon, and serves on numerous boards and commissions. She was a White House Fellow and served on staff of the U.S. Secretary of Education.



Among other teaching positions, Dr. Vines has served on the faculty at Boston University's School of Nursing in the Psychiatric/Community Mental Health Graduate Program and as dean of the School of Health for California State University, Dominguez Hills. She had taught psychiatric, pediatric, and medical surgical nursing in California, New York, and Massachusetts, and was a counselor and psychotherapist in private practice in Boston and West Los Angeles. Vines also held administrative and nursing positions at hospitals in New York, San Diego, Philadelphia, and Florida.

Dr. Vines received her bachelor's degree from Vanderbilt University, her master's from New York University, her doctorate in sociology from Boston University, and her associate degree from St. Petersburg Jr. College.
